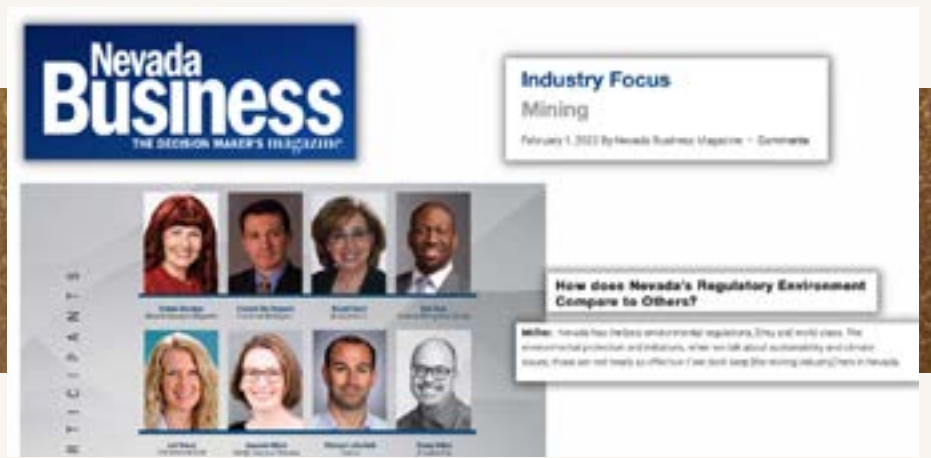




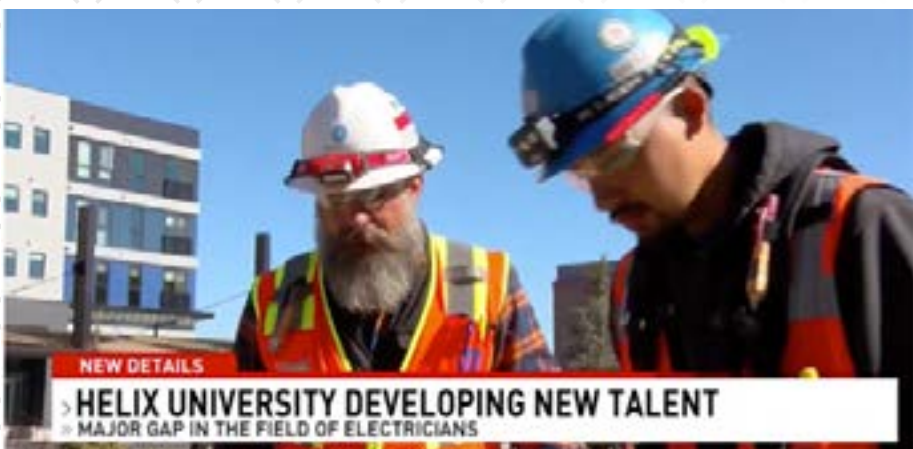
## GOODWILL® OF SOUTHERN NEVADA RECEIVES CHECK FROM NEVADA GOVERNOR STEVE SISOLAK
