### Gaming Industry Roundtable

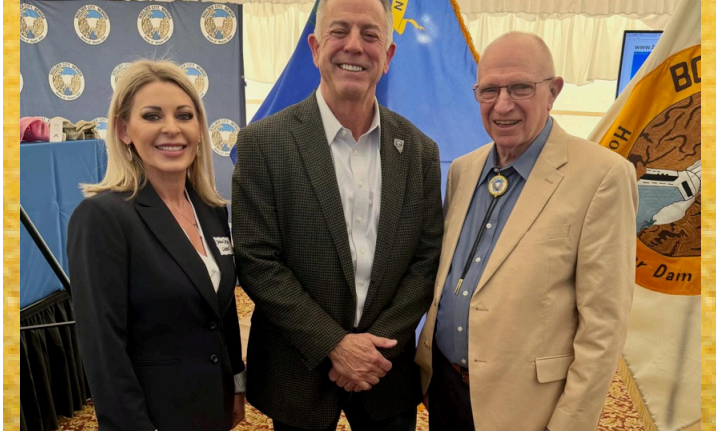
